RE-NOTIFICATION-CUM-PROSPECTUS for admission to BPES Integrated (4 years) programme 2023

1. Online Late Applications are invited for admission to Affiliated College/University Self financing Centres for the Physical Education Programme, **BPES Integrated Programme (4 years)** with entrance examination, for the Academic year 2023-24.

As per UO No. 14248/2023/Admn dated 15.09.2023, name of the 4 year BPEd (Integrated) Programme has been restructured to 4 year BPES (Integrated) Programme. Candidates who have already applied for BPEd (Integrated) Programme as per previous notification need not apply again and they will be considered for admission to 4 year BPES (Integrated) Programme.

3. Mode of Registration :

All candidates shall register through online mode only. Applications can be submitted online till 26.09.2023, 5.00 pm. Candidates shall visit the University admission website <https://admission.uoc.ac.in/> and access the Registration Link provided in the web page and complete the registration. If a candidate submits more than one application, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.

4. Procedure of application :

4.1. First Step - Mobile Number verification using OTP : Candidate applying for BPES Integrated 4 years (CUCAT 2023) shall provide mobile number and complete the mobile number verification using the OTP received in the mobile. Please ensure that mobile number of students/parents/guardian only is furnished.

4.2. Second Step - CAP ID Creation : Candidates shall initially create a CAP ID by providing the basic details using the "New User (Create CAP ID)" link provided in the registration page. After successful submission of the details, a CAP ID and Password will be sent to the registered mobile number.

4.3. Third Step - Registration Completion and Making Payment : With the CAP ID and Password received in the registered mobile number, the candidate can login and fill the registration page by providing required data. Candidates shall take utmost care while selecting the reservation category during the filling up of registration data. For completing the registration, candidate shall click on the "*Finalise & Proceed to Payment*" button and make payment. During payment, the website will be redirected to the University of Calicut Instant Web Payment System (CUIWPS) page where the student can select the desired choice of payment.

Mode of payment : The fee for online registration can be made only through e-payment system (SBI Online/ Payment Gateway/ Friends Janasevana Kendram/ Akshaya Kendras). Printout of the application will be provided only if the payment is successful.

Important Note : Application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

4.4. Candidate's application will be considered complete only if he/she has completed the above mentioned steps and is holding a final printout showing approved stamp on the candidate's photo.

4.5. After completion of online registration, the candidate should take printout of the same and keep it with himself/herself. **DO NOT SEND HARD COPIES OF THE PRINT OUT OF ONLINE APPLICATION OR ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY.** The hard copy of the online application with supporting documents should be kept by the candidate and it must be submitted at the time of admission to respective University centre/College. The CAP ID.No. is mandatory for downloading hall tickets for the entrance examinations. This I.D. number should also be kept and mentioned by the candidate in all future communications. Candidates have to retain the CAP ID as well as the password for this purpose.

5. Hall Tickets for Entrance Examination :

Candidates can download hall tickets for the entrance examination from University Website **5 days before the date of entrance examination.** No individual communication regarding entrance examination will be sent to the candidates. Candidates should go through the University Website and the University Press release for the latest information.

7. GENERAL CONDITIONS AND GUIDELINES :

1. Applicants must produce a valid nativity certificate from the competent authority of Kerala to prove that they are natives of Kerala, at the time of admission.
2. Ethnic native Lakshadweep candidates are exempted from appearing the entrance examinations based on the sponsorship letter from the Lakshadweep Administration, subject to eligibility (U.O. No:14933/2016/Admn dated 26.12.2016). One seat in each UG/PG programme is additionally created and reserved over and above the sanctioned strength for the native students of the Union Territory of Lakshadweep, recommended by the Director of Education, Union Territory of Lakshadweep.
3. Interview, Physical test, Sports achievement certificate verification etc. will be done by the concerned Department before finalising the rank list.
4. The type of questions for the entrance examination shall be objective type (Multiple Choice) only and there will be negative marks for each wrong answer.
5. Syllabus and Question Paper of entrance exams will be based on the eligibility of the programme.
6. Date of commencement of classes will be informed through press release/University Website.
7. No fees other than those prescribed by the University/Govt. shall be levied from the students. (U.O.No:520/2019/Admn dated 14.01.2019 & Circular No:1680/DOA-ASST-2/2015/Admn, dated 08.02.2019).

8. Fee Structure will be published in the website

9. Sports Quota : One seat in each programme shall be additionally created and reserved over and above the sanctioned strength. The candidates who seek admission through sports quota should register through online. In addition to this, candidates seeking admission under sports quota shall submit copy of their application to the Department of Physical Education (DPE) before the last date of online registration along with necessary documents for getting considered to be included in the sports quota rank list prepared by the Department of Physical Education. Only those candidates who have satisfied the norms prescribed below are eligible for admission under sports quota. [U.O. No. 9697/2015 dated : 14.09.2015(PG)].

1. Representing the Country in International Competitions.
2. Winning the I / II / III in the Senior National Championships.
3. Representing Senior State in National Championships.
4. Winning I / II / III in the All India Inter University Championships.
5. Representing the University (U.O.No. GA I/A2/2454 / 1998 dated 01.10.1999 & 01.07.2003 and GA I/A2/5990 / 2003 dated 06.04.2004).
6. Member of the University Teams.
7. First/Second position in the Senior State Championship.
8. First position in the Inter Collegiate Inter zone Championship (1st preference to be given to University of Calicut, then MG University, then University of Kerala and then Kannur University).
9. Medal winners in Junior National Championship.
10. Persons representing the State in Junior National Championships.
11. I/II/III position holders in the inter Collegiate inter Zone Tournaments. (Norms 6, 7, 8 are added as per U O No.6494/2014/Admn dated. 07.07.2014, Norms 9,10,11 are added as per UO No.13627/2016/Admn dated 21/11/2016).

10. Refund of fee collected : The norms regarding the refund of fees collected from the students at the time of admission, is shown below (as per U.O.No:14061/Admn, dated 13.09.2023).

*(Inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit). In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) as processing charges from the refundable amount. Fees shall be refunded by all HEIs to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.

11. Mandatory Reservation :

11.1. Claim for Communal reservation under 'Socially and Educationally Backward Classes' (SEBC) : Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, G.O. (Ms) No.107/08/H.Edn dated 30.08.2008, and G.O. (P) 2/2017BCDD, Dated 8.3.2017 as amended from time to time. Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindus, Latin Catholic other than Anglo Indians and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC Quota should invariably produce both community and non-creamy layer certificates obtained from the Village Officer/Tahsildar and should be produced at the time of admission. Candidates whose annual family income is above the amount stipulated by the Govt. for this purpose from time to time are not eligible for reservation. The seats unavailed by SEBC category candidates will be allotted under open quota.

11.2. Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribe Quota : Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the Caste/Community Certificate from the Tahsildar. The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidates and vice versa .

11.3. Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates: Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates who claim allotment to the unavailed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota should furnish Community and Income certificates obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Those OEC candidates whose annual family income is up to the amount stipulated by the Govt. for this purpose from time to time alone are eligible for such seats.

No advance fee shall be collected from SC/ST/OEC Communities and 30 other communities who are availing educational concession as is given to OEC. (UO No 2593/2020/Admn dated 26.02.2020).

11.4. EWS (Economically Weaker Sections) : Candidates coming under SC/ST/OEC/SEBC are not eligible for EWS reservation. Only general category candidates who are not enjoying any communal reservation and belonging to economically weaker class are eligible for EWS reservation (U.O.No. 10306/2022/Admn dated 21.05.2022). The seats for EWS will be filled by the University for the programmes in University Teaching Departments/University Centres/Affiliated Colleges (In all those institutions which do not have minority status and allow reservation to other backward classes) from the registered students belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (U.O.No. 4958/2020/Admn Dated, 29.05.2020 & U.O.No.7158/2020/Admn Dated,28.07.2020 & GO(Ms).No. 216/2022/Admn Dated 07.05.2022). Please see G.O.(Ms) No.23/2022/P&ARD Dated 04.10.2022, which includes the format for EWS certificate to be obtained from Village Officer. An Income & Assets Certificate below Rs.4 lakh (Appendix I) or AAY and PHH Certificate (Appendix II) issued from Village Officer/Tahsildar should be produced at the time of admission, by the candidates who wish to avail reservation under EWS category
